The Chiang Mai Rugby 11s is oh so excited to be back! With 17 teams from, Papua New Guinea, Philippines, Thailand and Vietnam coming to Chiang Mai for the tournament. It will bring some much-needed relief for a lot of business owners, as well as providing some spectacular sporting action on the pitch. This year we have a new brand sponsor and we welcome **DRAGON COURIER** to the 11s rugby family and look forward to a long and fruitful relationship with them, around the Asia region.

With the continued success of the Rugby 11s concept at last years event, Chiang Mai continues to be at the forefront of this innovative 11s brand of rugby, along with the Phuket International Rugby 11s, held annually in June.

This year's tournament venue is the <u>Suthep Municipal Stadium</u> situated in the foothills of Doi Suthep. With the vet's tournament, it's a chance to see rugby of a bygone era, being played out in a spirit of camaraderie and fun. Even though their creaky old bodies might complain about the rigours of getting out of bed, never mind running around on a rugby pitch, they can still talk a good game, especially when liberally lubricated.

At Suthep stadium on Sunday, there will be a rugby camp in conjunction with the <u>Lanna Rugby Club's</u> Youth development program. Teams are invited to send interested coaches and/or players, to get involved from 10:00am.

Jean Luc is the referee's manager, and his team of officials will be keeping order on the pitch and creating mayhem, off it!



NOVA RFUC








We always love making the trip down to Chiang Mai and have a long-standing, great relationship with the Chiang Mai Cobras making this tournament one of our favourite events of the year.

REFEREE'S EXPECTATIONS

- 1) Strict adherence to the Laws of the Games as prescribed by World Rugby
- 2) Yellow/Red Cards
- This will and shall be given out for foul play and repeated individual/team infringements
- For high tackle, we will deal with it as how the Referee sees it. Mitigating factors will be taken into consideration by the Referee officiating the match.
- Red Card suspension is prescribed in the Tournament Guidelines and/or at the discretion of the Main Committee of the Tournament
- 3) Time & Score
- Referees will keep time and score.
- Running time will be the rule and stopped only if there is a severe injury. This will be done at the next stoppage of play. ie Scrum, Lineout, Free Kick or Penalty. This will be at the discretion of the Referee officiating
- Referees will not stop play unless the injured/fallen player is in the way of the play.
- Doctor and Medics will attend to the same.
- Conversions kicks must be kicked within 30 seconds from the Try was awarded
- Penalty kicks must be kicked within 30 seconds from the time the Team indicated their intention to do so.
- A Restart kick must be taken within 30 seconds from the time of conversion has been taken or declined and/or from the time a penalty goal or dropped kick is kicked.
- 4) Zero Tolerance to Abuse & Foul Play
- -No Excuses
- -No Reasons
- -No Arguments
- Abuse of any Match Official will be an immediate expulsion of the said individual from the tournament
- 5) Decision making:
- the Referee
- i) may consult the Assistant Referee about any matters relating to foul play
- li) may alter his decision if he made such a consultation
- iii) has the power to stop play at any time
- 6) The Referee is the sole judge of fact and of law during the match and his decision is final

RUGBY PLAYER & HEAVYWEIGHT MUAY THAI BOXER



Since landing in Thailand back in April, Alongside Muay Thai, I've been playing rugby for the Chiang Mai Cobras since I arrived, and that team has become a massive part of my life.

I've played in the Phuket International Rugby11s and Pattaya 10s with them, and even picked up an AC joint injury in Phuket fighting for the boys — but I still kept training and pushing forward because this is what I'm here for.

Next weekend I'll be running out again for Chiang Mai in the Dragon Courier Chiang Mai Rugby 11s, and I'm hoping to follow the Cobras around the country in the future as we take on tournaments down south and everywhere else,

I've been fully locked into this journey — training and fighting Muay Thai full-time in Chiang Mai while building a proper life out here. I'm currently 2–0 with two first-round knockouts, and recently I've been offered the chance to train with the head trainer at Buakaw's gym in Koh Samui — a former Southern Thai champion with over 380 fights — which means world-class training, better fight money, and a real shot at pushing this as far as I can.
